SPECIAL CONDITIONS TO NOTE

All sheep forward for the sale will be subject to a society inspection. Any animal which does not reach the inspection standard will not be eligible for sale. The Inspectors decision will be final, and any animal which fails will be removed from the sale and forfeit the entry fee.

- The Vendor shall be responsible for the correctness of identity.
- **Substitutes to the Society office no later than 12 noon Thursday 10th December - NONE accepted on the day**
- All sheep accepted into the market on the day of sale only.

IMPORTANT NOTE TO VENDORS:

NO STRAW or SHAVINGS in the pens.

All sheep must arrive at the Market accompanied with a
DEFRA ARAM Form and White SAC MV Form

IMPORTANT NOTE TO PURCHASERS

All sheep are to be removed on the day of sale.

Please ensure you have a holding number and address details available when collecting your invoice, passout and licence.

TO ALL WHO ATTEND THE SALE

The sale will be run under the DEFRA rules and regulations in place on the day.
The current standstill rules will apply.

Skipton In Lamb Sale - General Sale Bye-Laws

1. All UK-bred sheep and imported sheep entered at Society sales must be fully registered and all fees paid prior to the Sale.
2. All tags must comply with UK legislation and Society rules on identification.
3. Substitutes must be declared to the Society and Auctioneers within 48 hours prior to the sale, and must be marked with a red dot on the loin.
4. Scrapie genotyping is voluntary. All sheep catalogued with scrapie genotype must have valid certificates (whether NSP or Private test).
5. The upset (minimum) price is 200gns at the Skipton In Lamb Sale.
6. All sheep entered for Society sales must be inspected by a panel of inspectors appointed by the Society.
7. The inclusion of any animal in the show and/or sale following any inspection is no warranty that the particular animal meets any criteria or criterion in respects of any standards or will do so in the future.
8. Entry forms – Entries will be returned if certificates are not included.
9. Sale Ring Rule – Any sheep which has not passed Society inspection must not be offered for sale, or advertised or promoted, in the ring.
10. Transfers – Any sheep to be sold at Society sales must be registered in the flock from which it is to be sold by 31st May in the year of sale.
11. Inspection – All sheep forward must be back-stamped with the lot number, failure to do so will result in rejection.
12. **Any females which have been flushed and embryos recovered before sale must be declared in the catalogue and announced at the time of sale. Failure to do so will result in the purchaser having the right to return the sheep. Costs may be incurred.**
13. Joint entries are not allowed. All members to enter their own sheep and be balloted individually.
14. No double entries allowed.

Inspections

1. Tags which do not comply with UK legislation and Society requirements will result in the sheep being rejected at inspection. From 2008 all registered lambs must carry tags with the Society logo. Check that tags are correct at time of entry, so that replacement tags can be ordered before the sale.
2. Inspection – All sheep forward must be back-stamped with the lot number, failure to do so will result in rejection.
3. Sheep which have failed inspection will be identified by a neck tag marked 'Reject', or may be removed immediately from the market premises..
4. Rejected sheep which are to be penned with the rest of the consignment must be identified by a neck tag marked 'Reject'. It is a condition of entry that this rule is strictly adhered to. Vendors are advised to check their animals thoroughly prior to departure from home.
5. Inspection will include the following points:- Teeth and Testicles, Mobility Udder, Muscularity and any other points deemed necessary by Council as they see fit.

Inspection Standards

TEETH –To be scored on a 1-5 scale, where 1 is extremely undershot and 5 is extremely overshot, with 3 being perfect. A score of 2 ½, 3, and 3 ½ is all that is acceptable.

MOBILITY – Sheep should be mobile and sound. Rams should be capable of natural service.

TESTICLES - Should be of even size, move freely and be free of abnormalities.

DOUBLE MUSCLING – Sheep should display double-muscled gigots.

UDDER - Should be correct and free of abnormalities.

FLEECE – Should be tight. A medium fleece may be acceptable.

Appeals

Appeals against an inspection decision may be made to the Chief Inspector or Society Secretary. A deposit of £50 (refundable if appeal is successful) must be lodged and the sheep will then be inspected by an appeals team of three people elected prior to the sale by Council. The decision of the appeals committee is final. Appeal to be lodged within 1 hour of the inspection decision.

Shows at Sales

1. Each vendor is allowed two entries in each pre-sale show class.
2. All exhibitors should be dressed in a white coat at all times in the show rings.
3. All prize winners must be offered for sale at auction by the exhibitor at the sale following the show. Awards may be withheld and prize monies will be forfeited unless prize winners are sold by auction.
4. The decision of the judge is final.

AUCTIONEER'S CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. **BIDDING:** the highest bidder shall be the purchaser and any dispute which arises shall be settled by the Auctioneer who shall regulate the bidding and have the right to refuse a bid.
2. **GUINEAS:** All sheep at the sale shall be sold in guineas unless otherwise stated.
3. **PURCHASER'S RESPONSIBILITY:** Each lot shall be at the sole risk of the purchaser at the fall of the hammer.
4. **PAYMENT:** All purchases shall be paid for on the day of sale direct to the Auctioneers before removal and no lot to be removed without written authority of the Auctioneers. Cheques will not be accepted unless prior arrangements with the Auctioneers have been made. Where a purchaser defaults in payment, the Auctioneers reserve the right to re-sell the lot and to charge the purchaser with any expenses and loss incurred by the reason of the failure of the Purchaser to complete his purchase. The Auctioneers reserve the right to charge interest at the current bank overdraft rate on any outstanding accounts from the day of sale unless special arrangements have been made with the Auctioneer in this respect.
5. **DESCRIPTION:** The descriptions are supplied by the vendors who alone are responsible for details and accuracy. The auctioneers will not be answerable in respect of any errors which may occur in the catalogue. The Auctioneers may make an intimation of any alteration or modification of the catalogue description of any lot immediately before the asking for bids. The Auctioneer shall be the sole and executive judge of the fact of such intimation and the terms in which it is made.
6. Any dispute over warranties, pedigrees or matters not dealt with specifically in these conditions will be settled in accordance with the rules of the British Texel Sheep Society.
7. The **VENDOR** warrants that any female sheep sold as being In Lamb is In Lamb at the time of sale. This warranty is a 21 day warranty – LAA Conditions of Sale 40.1
8. The Sales Committee may appoint, at their discretion, an arbitrator acting under the Arbitration Acts for the time being in force, in order to resolve any dispute. In each case the person having the reference shall have full power to include in his award provisions for costs and expenses including the keep and transport of the animal.
9. Without prejudice to the discretion of any person making an award as aforesaid, the purchaser shall be responsible for the cost of returning the animal to the sale yard or elsewhere at the Auctioneers' discretion and the vendor shall pay reasonable lirage until collection of that lot.
10. Purchasers are responsible for ascertaining the genotype of individual sheep from the vendors.

COVID 19 REGULATIONS

From 8th August 2020

Please note the following change from the above date:

NO VISTORS/CHILDREN ARE PERMITTED TO THE MART – ACTIVE CUSTOMERS ONLY.

FACE COVERINGS –

As from 8th August the wearing of face coverings is MANDATORY in enclosed public spaces including Auction Houses. Wearing a face covering is mandatory at ALL our sales for ALL customers. Please bring one with you.

VENDORS –

Vendors may unload their trailers and stay to represent their stock being sold. Arrive on site and put paper work in the box on the docks then move your vehicle and wash out.

Stay at your pen and sort stock or go to café until sale time.

You can come to the sale ring side to represent stock during sale.

All luck money must be stated on the Vendor Forms and is deducted at the rostrum. You may collect cheques/bacs statements from the office one person at a time.

ALL VENDORS MUST SOCIALLY DISTANCE AT ALL TIMES.

WE ASK THAT VENDORS MUST NOT APPROCH BUYERS AT THE RINGSIDE.

DROP & GO – This system is still in place for anyone not comfortable with attending the mart. Please ensure stock comes with correctly completed paperwork.

BUYERS –

Must ring to register to attend all sales.

Arrive at mart and book in at the security table on the main concourse.

There is always a viewing period for buyers to go round the pens before sale.

Buyers can enter the office one person at a time.

ALL BUYERS MUST SOCIALLY DISTANCE AT ALL TIMES.

CHILDREN – Please **do not** bring your **children** to the Livestock market.

CAFE – The **cafe** is open for **TAKEAWAY** only.

ALL CUSTOMERS – we need to be aware that there is a very real risk that a positive case of Covid 19 identified through Trace and Track to a premises could result in the closure of those premises for 14 days. PLEASE do not attend the mart if you are showing any symptoms.
