38 Female sheep not described as In Lamb

38.1 Vendor's warranty

The Vendor warrants that a female sheep not described in any catalogue for sale or at the time of sale as In Lamb is not In Lamb at the time of sale. This warranty is a **14 Week + 5 Day Warranty**.

38.2 Purchaser's rights

If the *Purchaser* proves a breach of warranty then, at the Purchaser's option, either the *Purchaser* may exercise his rights under Schedule 6, or the Vendor shall pay to the *Purchaser as Liquidated Damages* a sum equal to the amount in paragraph (i) of the Appendix. Notice of a claim must be supported by a *Veterinary Surgeon's Certificate* or a slaughterhouse manager's or other competent person's certificate confirming that the sheep was *In Lamb*

39 Female sheep described as correct

39.1 Vendor's warrantv

The **Vendor** warrants that all female sheep described in the catalogue or at the time of sale as correct are sound in mouth and udder, that is they are not lacking any of the 8 broad teeth and do not have any damaged or worn teeth or a defective udder. This warranty is a **5 Day Warranty**.

39.2 Purchaser's rights

If the *Purchaser* proves a breach of warranty then, at the Purchaser's option, either the *Purchaser* may exercise his rights under Schedule 6, or the *Vendor* shall pay to the Purchaser as *Liquidated Damages* a sum equal to the amount in paragraph (i) of the Appendix. Notice of a claim must be supported by *Veterinary Surgeon's Certificate*.

40 Female sheep proving barren

40.1 Vendor's warranty

The *Vendor* warrants that any female sheep sold as being In Lamb is In Lamb at the time of sale. *This warranty is a 21 Day Warranty.*

40.2 Purchaser's rights

If the *Purchaser* proves a breach of warranty he may exercise his rights under Schedule. Notice of a claim must be supported by a *Veterinary Surgeon's Certificate*.

43 Stock rams

43.1 Vendor's warranty

The **Vendor** warrants that any ram sold as a stock ram for the amount in paragraph (j) of appendix or more is capable of natural service. This warranty lasts from the day of sale to the **15th December** in the year of the sale.

43.2 Purchaser's rights

If the *Purchaser* proves a breach of warranty the *Purchaser* may return the ram to the *Vendor* who shall, at the Purchaser's option, either replace the ram with another ram of equal value which is capable of natural service, or refund the purchase price together with such other costs and charges as the *Purchaser* may be entitled to under these Conditions.

For the avoidance of any doubt if the Purchaser is able to obtain viable semen from the ram for use by artificial insemination he shall not be entitled to any claim against the **Vendor for breach of warrantv**.

BELTEX THE STANDARD OF EXCELLENCE

General Appearance

The Beltex is a medium sized sheep, long in body. It is wedge shaped from a narrow shoulder to a distinctive large double-muscled hind quarter.

Head

The head is generally white in colour but may have black, blue or brown shadings or patches.

Colour is irrelevant to quality. The fore face is short and thick.

Neck

The neck is thick and short.

Body

Well muscled shoulder. A wide back and long barrel shaped body

Gigots

The distinctive characteristic of Beltex Sheep is the double-muscled hindquarters, sloping pelvis, low set tail, deep flushed, well rounded and full of meat. The excessive hindquarter development when compared to the line of the shoulders gives a wedge shaped appearance.

Legs

Sheep should be mobile and capable of natural service. Joints should be straight and sound. Legs are usually white but colour is relevant. Feet tight. Pasterns upright. Fine bone structure.

Fleece

Tight, dense of medium staple length, affording a good protective birth coat to the lamb.

A medium to tight fleece is tolerated.

Bone

Fine bone is a desirable characteristic.

Teeth

Teeth are scored on a 1 to 5 scale, where 1 is extreme and 5 extreme overshot, with 3 being perfect. Only animals with a score of 2, 3 or 4 are considered acceptable.

General Conditions and Sale Bye-Laws

General Sale Bye-Laws

- All UK-bred sheep entered at Society/Club sales must be fully registered and all fees paid prior to the sale, with the exception of spring ewe and lamb sales where lambs need only be birth notified prior to sale and fully registered, at cost to the vendor, if sold.
- 2. All tags must comply with UK legislation and Society rules on identification.
- 3. Substitutes must be declared to the Society within the specified time stated on the sale entry form and catalogue, and must be marked with a red dot on the loin.
- 4. Scrapie genotyping is voluntary, but is included in the standard DNA sample for sires used and ewes flushed. All sheep catalogued with scrapie genotype must have valid certificates.
- 5. The upset (minimum) price is 300gns at the Premier Sale. At all other Society/Club sales, the upset price shall be decided between the Society/Club and the auctioneer.
- Runs are limited to 10, extra runs are placed at the end of the sale (see Carlisle Premier Special Sale Bye-Laws for exceptions).
- All sheep entered for Society/Club sales must be inspected by a panel of inspectors appointed by the Society. Some sales will also have a Veterinary Officer aiding with the inspection.
- 8. The inclusion of any animal in the show and/or sale following any inspection is no warranty that the particular animal meets any criteria or criterion in respects of any standards, or will do so in the future.
- 9. Entry forms must be submitted with all relevant paper work.
- Any sheep which has not passed Society/Club inspection should be removed from the vendor's pen
 as soon as possible, and must not be offered for sale, or advertised or promoted, in the ring.
- 11. No animal to be sold outside of the ring before entering the sale ring.
- 12. All animals must be sold in catalogue order.
- Any sheep to be sold at Society sales must be registered in the flock from which it is to be sold by 31
 May in the year of sale.
- 14. All sheep forward must be back-stamped with the lot number, with the exception of those at spring ewe and lamb sales. Failure to do so will result in rejection from sale.
- 15. Any rams with semen taken or retained before sale, or females which have been flushed and embryos recovered before sale, must be declared in the entry forms and catalogue and announced at the time of sale. Failure to do so will result in the purchaser having the right to return the sheep. Costs may be incurred by the vendor.
- Recipients carrying pedigree embryos will be allowed to be sold at the in-lamb female sales after fully registered sheep.
- 17. All sheep entered at in-lamb sales will be scanned at time of inspection.
- 18. Substitutes allowance per vendor at any sale is three shearling rams, and two per other section. These must be notified to the Society by the time specified on the entry form/catalogue. No substitutes will be allowed on the day. Any un-notified substitutes must be removed from the vendor's pen as soon as possible and must not be offered for sale through the ring.

Note Re Point 15: Council advise the following: Tick the box on the entry forms and make sure information is given out at time of sale. The vendor must discuss fully with the purchaser any details of retained semen/embryos, specifically whether for own use or if intending to sell. This should be agreed between vendor and purchaser, preferably in writing and signed by both parties.

Inspections

19. Tags which do not comply with UK legislation and Society requirements will result in the sheep being rejected at inspection. From 2008, all registered lambs must carry tags with the Society logo. Check that tags are correct at time of entry so that replacement tags can be ordered before the sale.

- All sheep forward must be back-stamped with the lot number, with the exception of those at spring
 ewe and lamb sales. Failure to do so will result in rejection from sale.
- 21. Sheep which have failed inspection must be removed immediately from the market premises. Vendors are advised to check their animals thoroughly prior to departure from home.
- 22. Any animal rejected for testicle abnormality or incorrect mouth is not allowed to be entered or substituted at later Society/Club sales, with the exception of lambs which may be entered at sales the following year as shearlings.
- 23. Inspection will include the following points tags, teeth, testicles, udder, muscularity and any other points deemed necessary by Council as they see fit.

Inspection Standards

- a. Teeth to be inspected and assessed at the discretion of the inspector/veterinary officer. Teeth must meet the pad, not be overshot or undershot, and no tampering with teeth is permitted.
- b. All sheep should be mobile and rams capable of natural service.
- c. Testicles should be of even size, free of abnormalities and move freely. Minimum testicle size 27cm for ram lambs and 30 cm for shearling rams and aged rams. Testicles will be measured at the vet/inspector's discretion.
- d. Udders should be correct and free of any hardness or abnormalities.

The vet and inspector's decision will be final at each sale.

24. Shows at Sales

- Each vendor is allowed two entries in each pre-sale show class, bar the Carlisle Premier Sale where only one entry per class is allowed.
- b. All exhibitors should be dressed in a white coat in the show ring.
- c. Exhibitors are permitted to prepare their sheep to the best of their ability.
- d. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that each exhibit is available for judging at the correct time.
- e. All prize winners must be offered for sale at auction by the exhibitor at the sale following the show, otherwise awards may be withheld and prize monies forfeited.
- f. The decision of the judge is final.

25. Sales held under the auspices of the Beltex Sheep Society

All sheep sold at any Society/Club sale must be registered with the Beltex Sheep Society.
 Cross-bred sheep must not be listed in any Society catalogue unlesstcarrying pedigree embryos.

Dispersal (No Inspection required) **Production and Reduction** (Inspection required) Sales to be held at the end of the collective sale and no sheep to be shown in the pre-sale show.

26. Sale Conditions

The sale terms and conditions of the LAAS / IAAS shall apply to Beltex Society and club sales with the exception of the duration of the stock ram warranty.

Rams purchased at Society and club sales must prove to be capable of, and effective at, getting at least 1 female in lamb by **15th December** in the year of purchase.

Claims must be notified to the auctioneers by **31st December** and must be supported by vets' reports and any other proof of infertility or incapability. No claim after that date will be accepted.

The auctioneers shall be mediators in disputes between buyer and seller.

Warranty Rights and Return of Stock:

- 1. Failure of purchasers to comply with conditions:
- 1.1. If the purchaser does not comply in every particular with the Conditions in this Part he shall be bound to keep the lot with all faults and shall have no claim for damages or otherwise against any person in respect of the sale.
- 1.2. The purchaser may not make any claim under these Conditions unless he has paid the purchase money in full before the claim is made.
- 2. Faults and errors of description:
- 2.1. Except as expressly provided in these Conditions there shall be no condition or warranty, otherwise than as to title, in regard to any lots sold and the purchaser shall take delivery of each lot with all faults, imperfections and errors of descriptions.
- 3. Remedy for breach of warranty, other than the warranty of title:
- 3.1. Except where otherwise expressly provided, the breach or any warranty in these Conditions shall give the purchaser a right to refuse to take delivery or return the animal in accordance with these Conditions and to recover such reasonable costs and charges as he may be entitled to under these Conditions, but shall give him no right to claim damages from the vendor in lieu of exercising such right of refusal or return. Purchasers are entitled to the remedies set out in these Conditions, but to no others.
- 3.2. No claim by a purchaser under these Conditions shall be valid unless the purchaser notifies the auctioneers in the manner and within the time prescribed.
- 3.3. Where under these Conditions the purchaser has the option of returning an animal or claiming damages then, unless within 3 days after first notifying the auctioneers or the vendor of his claim he either returns the animal to the auctioneers or, as the auctioneers may direct, to the vendor or gives notice in writing to the auctioneers and the vendor of his intention to return the animal and of his willingness to comply with any directions which may be given to him regarding the return of the animal, the purchaser shall be taken to taken to have elected to claim damages and have waived any right to return the animal.
- 1. Where under these Conditions the purchaser's sole remedy is to return the animal it shall be returned within 3 days of a request by the auctioneers.
- 1. Procedure in the cases of contested claims for breach of warranty:
- No claim by a purchaser than an animal does not comply with any warranty, other than any warranty of title, shall be valid unless:
- the purchaser notifies the auctioneers in the manner and within the time prescribed and provides any veterinary surgeons certificate or other persons certificate or opinion required by these Conditions; and
- in a case where the purchaser claims the right to reject an animal on the ground that its physical
 conditions constitutes a breach of warranty and the vendor calls for a veterinary surgeon's
 certificate the purchaser provides with such reasonable period as the auctioneers may specify.
- Notwithstanding any other provision of these Conditions, where by these Conditions any veterinary surgeons certificate or other persons certificate or opinion must be provided within any specified period the auctioneers may, either before or after the expiration of the specified period, allow such further time for the delivery of the certificate or opinion as they in their solo discretion think fit and where the certificate or opinion as they in their solo discretion think fit and where the certificate or opinion is provided within that further time the purchasers claim shall be as effective as if the certificate or opinion had been provided within the specified period.

Conditions of Sale:

1. Female sheep not described as in lamb

1.1. Vendors warranty

The vendor warrant that a female sheep not described in the catalogue or at the time of sale as in lamb is not in lamb at the time of sale. The warranty is a 14 week +5 day warranty.

1.2. Purchasers rights

If the purchaser proves a breach of warranty then, at the purchasers option, either the purchaser may exercise his rights under condition 2. Notice of a claim must be supported by a veterinary surgeons certificate or a slaughterhouse managers or other competent person's certificate confirming that the sheep was in lamb.

2. Female sheep described as correct

2.1. Vendors warranty

The vendor warrants that all female sheep described in the catalogue or at the time of sale as correct are sound in mouth and udder, that they are not lacking any of the 8 broad teeth and do no have any damaged or worn teeth or a defective udder. This warranty is a 5 day warranty.

2.2. Purchasers rights

If the purchaser proves a breach of warranty then, at the purchaser option, either the purchaser may exercise his rights under condition 7, or the vendor shall pay the purchaser as liquidated damages a sum equal to the amount in paragraph (b) of the Appendix. Notice of a claim must be supported by a veterinary surgeons certificate.

3. Female sheep proving barren

3.1. Vendors warranty

The vendor warrants than any female sheep sold as being in lamb is in lamb at the time of sale. This warranty is a 21 day warranty.

3.2. Purchasers rights

If the purchaser proves a breach of warranty he may exercise his rights under condition 7. Notice of a claim must be supported by a veterinary surgeons certificate.

4. Stock rams

4.1. Vendors warranty

The vendor warrants that any ram sold as a stock ram for 200gns (£210.00) or more is capable of natural and effective service. This warranty if a 3 month warranty, from the date of sale.

The animal shall be deemed incapable of natural and effective service if it fails to make at least five ewes pregnant by the end of the guarantee period.

The warranty is dependent on the ram being used under natural breeding conditions. Natural breeding condition is considered to be when a ram is run with ewes, cycling without artificial interference. Ewes, which have been 'sponged' and/or treated with hormones to induce or synchronise ovulation, shall not, for the purpose of the warranty, be in 'normal' condition. Natural breeding for the ram is considered to be when the ram serves the ewes naturally and the warranty does not cover AI usage.

4.2. Purchasers rights

The initial purchaser shall throughout the warranty period, give the ram full and sufficient opportunity to prove that he is capable of natural and effective service.

If the purchaser believes that the ram is not working naturally then he should forthwith advise the auctioneers in writing, who in turn shall notify the vendor. The purchaser shall forward a veterinary certificate to the auctioneers within 14 days of initial notification to lodge a claim.

The veterinary certificate must confirm that :-

a) The rams incapacity or ineffectiveness is not the result of injury, accident, illness or usage for AI happening after the time of sale. Death from natural causes within the male warranty period voids any liability under the warranty.

b) The Purchasers breeding females, to which the ram has been mated, are not responsible for the rams incapacity or ineffectiveness, and that they are in normal breeding condition.

The veterinary certificate will not be based on as semen sample collected by electro-ejaculation.

If the purchaser proves a breach of warranty then the purchaser may return the ram to the vendor who shall, at the purchasers option, either replace the ram with another ram of equal value which is capable of and effective at natural service, or refund the purchase price together with the cost of transport from the purchasers premises and the veterinary fees associated with proving infertility.

The vendor will not, under any circumstances be liable for indirect or consequential loss sustained by the purchaser.

Warranty Rights and Return of Stock:

- 5. Failure of purchaser to comply with conditions
- 5.1. If the purchaser does not comply in every particular with the conditions in this part he shall be bound to keep the lot with all faults and shall have no claim for damages or otherwise against any person in respect of the sale.
- 5.2. The purchaser may not make any claim under these conditions unless he has paid the purchase money in full before the claim is made.
- 6. Faults and errors of description
- 6.1. Except as expressly provided in these conditions there shall be no condition or warranty, otherwise than as to title, in regard to any lots sold and the purchaser shall take delivery or each lot with all faults, imperfections and errors of descriptions.
- 7. Remedy for breach of warranty, other than the warranty of title
- 7.1. Except where otherwise expressly provided, the breach of any warranty in these conditions shall give the purchaser a right to refuse to take delivery of or to return the animal in accordance with these conditions and to recover such reasonable costs and charges as he may be entitled to under these conditions, but shall give him no right to claim damages from the vendor in lieu of exercising such right of refusal or return. Purchasers are entitled to the remedies set out in these conditions, but to no others.
- 7.2. No claim by a purchaser under these conditions shall be valid unless the purchaser notifies the auctioneers in the manner and within the time prescribed.
- 7.3. Where under these conditions the purchaser has the option of returning an animal or claiming damages then, unless within 3 days after first notifying the auctioneers or the vendor of his claim he either returns the animal to the auctioneers or, as the auctioneers may direct, to the vendor or gives notice in writing to the auctioneers and the vendor of his intention to return the animal and of his willingness to comply with any directions which may be given to him regarding the return of the animal, the purchaser shall be taken to have elected to claim damages and the have waived any right to return the animal.
- 7.4. Where under these conditions the purchases sole remedy is to return the animal it shall be returned within 3 days if a request by the auctioneers.
- 8. Procedure in the cases of contested claims for breach of warranty
- 8.1. No claim by a purchase that an animal does not comply with any warranty, other than any warranty of title, shall be valid unless:
- The purchaser notifies the auctioneers in the manner and within the time prescribed and provides any veterinary surgeons certificate or other persons certificate or opinion required by these conditions; and
- b) In a case where the purchaser claims the right to reject an animal on the ground that its physical condition constitutes a breach of warranty and the vendor calls for a veterinary surgeons certificate the purchaser provides that certificate within such reasonable period as the auctioneers may specify.

- 8.2. Notwithstanding any other provision of these conditions, where by these conditions any veterinary surgeons certificate or other persons certificate or opinion must be provided within any specified period the auctioneers may, either before or after the expiration of the specified period, allow such further time for the delivery of the certificate or opinion as they in their sole discretion think fit and where the certificate or opinion is provided within that further time the purchasers claim shall be as effective as if the certificate or opinion had been provided within the specified period.
- 8.3. If the vendor disputes the purchasers claim for breach of warranty, the claim shall be referred for decision to the auctioneers or to such other person as the auctioneers may appoint for the purpose (in either case 'the referee'). The referee, who shall act as an expert and not as an arbitrator, shall make such examination or trail of the animal and such inquiry of such persons as in his sole discretion he considers necessary or desirable for determining the dispute.
- 8.4. The decision of the referee on any matter referred to him, which shall include the question whether any disease is or is not, whether by reason of its temporary character or otherwise, such as to constitute a breach of warranty, and on whether any animal which is to be returned shall be returned to the premises of the vendor or of the auctioneers, shall be final and binding upon both vendor and purchaser provided that either the vendor or the purchaser so requests in writing within 14 days after the decision the referee shall within 21 days after receiving such a request put his decision into writing and send a copy to each of the vendor and purchaser.
- 8.5. The party against whom any decision is given shall pay all reasonable expenses incurred by the auctioneers in connection therewith, including the costs of any examination or inquiry and the fees of any person appointed by the auctioneer to give any decision or to make any examination, trial or inquiry.
- 9. Return of stock
- 9.1. Where a purchaser exercises his right under these condition to refuse to take delivery of any animal or to return it to the vendor he shall be entitled to the return of which part of the purchase money as he has paid (and need not pay any part of it which he has not paid) and to a refund of the reasonable costs and expenses incurred by him in obtaining any veterinary surgeons certificate or other persons certificate or opinion which he is required to furnish under these conditions in order to exercise his right.
- 9.2. Where a purchaser exercises his right to return an animal he shall do so at his own expense but the vendor shall pay to the purchaser the reasonable costs and charges of the transit of such animal to and from the purchasers premises and, in the case of an animal which has been on the purchasers premises for not less than a week, the reasonable cost of its keep.
- 9.3. Should the purchaser of any animal return it without being entitled by these conditions to so he shall pay to the auctioneers and vendor all costs, expenses and damages which they may respectively sustain or incur as a consequence.
- 9.4. If any animal is returned by the purchaser to the auctioneers premises and neither the purchaser nor the vendor removes the animal within 3 days after written notice from the auctioneers to do so, the auctioneers may cause the animal to be re-sold by public or private sale without warranty or reserve and without further notice to the vendor or purchaser.
- 9.5. The moneys produced by the re-sale, after deducting the costs and charges of and attending the re-sale, a reasonable sum for the feed and care of the animal pending re-sale any veterinary surgeons charges necessarily or reasonably incurred, shall be held by the auctioneers on behalf of the person who proves to be entitled to them, or may be paid into court under interpleader proceedings.
- 9.6. If the moneys produced by the re-sale are insufficient to cover the costs and charges referred to in condition 9.5 the auctioneers shall be entitled to recover the deficiency from the person who was the owner of the animal immediately before its resale..
- 9.7. If a veterinary surgeon certifies that any animal returned to the auctioneers premises is suffering from disease or any other defect and in consequence ought to be slaughtered, the auctioneers may, after taking all reasonable steps to notify the purchaser and vendor, cause the animal to be slaughtered and shall be entitled to recover from the person who is the owner of the animal at the time when it is slaughtered the veterinary surgeons charges and a reasonable sum for the feed and care of the animal and its slaughter.

Appendix

The following figures and amounts apply for the purpose of the conditions stated as if set out in the conditions to which they relate:

Condition 2.2 40% of the purchase price up to and including a purchase price of £25 per head; 50% of the purchase price for the purchase price over £25 per head up to and including a purchase price of £50 per head; and 66% of the purchase price for a purchase price over £50 per head, in each case calculated on the average purchase price per head of the pen.

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
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
