### GENERAL INFORMATION AND SALE NOTES

### LOCATION:

The show and sale will be held at Worcester Livestock Market, Nunnery Way, Worcester.

M5, Junction 6 - take the A4538 signposted Evesham, approx ½ mile at the 2<sup>nd</sup> roundabout, turn right, signposted Hospital A&E and city centre. Follow road going over motorway and you will see the market on the left. When you get to the next roundabout turn left and the market entrance is 300 metres on the left.

From Herefordshire - A44/A4103 to A4440 ring road, turn right going round Worcester following signs towards M5, when arriving at roundabout at top of hill, take left turn now following signs to Hospital A&E, still on the A4440 ring road. At the next roundabout turn right onto Swinesherd Way, follow dual carriageway, straight over first roundabout. You will notice the market on the right hand side, proceed right round the second roundabout, coming back on yourself, the entrance to the market is approx 300 metres on your left.

### METHOD OF SALE:

All sheep will be sold in guineas.

### **CONDITIONS OF SALE:**

The sale is held subject to the LAA and the Auctioneers General Conditions of Sale.

### **SETTLEMENT & CLEARANCE:**

Settlement in full is due to the Auctioneers at the close of the sale. All sheep must be removed from the market on the day of sale.

### ACCOMMODATION:

There are a number of hotels and bed and breakfast accommodation in the area, which the Auctioneers would be pleased to recommend.

### **SUBSTITUTES**

### **General Sale Bye-Laws**

- 1. All UK-bred sheep entered at Society sales must be fully registered and all fees paid prior to the Sale.
- 2. All tags must comply with UK legislation and Society rules on identification.
- 3. Substitutes must be declared to the Society and Auctioneers within the specified time stated on the sale entry form and must be marked with a red dot on the loin.
- 4. Scrapie genotyping is voluntary. All sheep catalogued with scrapie genotype must have valid certificates.
- 5. The upset (minimum) price is 300gns at the Premier Sale. At all other Society sales, the upset price is 200gns.
- 6. Runs limited to 10, extra runs placed at end of the sale.
- 7. All sheep entered for Society sales must be inspected by a panel of inspectors appointed by the Society. Some sales will also have a Veterinary Officer doing the inspection.
- 8. The inclusion of any animal in the show and/or sale following any inspection is no warranty that the particular animal meets any criteria or criterion in respects of any standards or will do so in the future.
- 9. Entry forms Entries will be returned if certificates are not included.
- 10. Sale Ring Rule Any sheep which has not passed Society inspection must not be offered for sale, or advertised or promoted, in the ring.
- 11. No animal to be sold outside of the ring before being entered in the sale ring.
- 12. All animals MUST be sold in sale catalogue order.
- 13. Transfers Any sheep to be sold at Society sales must be registered in the flock from which it is to be sold by 31st May in the year of sale.
- 14. Inspection All sheep forward must be back-stamped with the lot number, failure to do so will result in rejection.
- 15. Any rams with semen taken / retained before sale or females which have been flushed and embryos recovered before sale must be declared in the catalogue and announced at the time of sale. Failure to do so will result in the purchaser having the right to return the sheep. Costs may be incurred.
- 16. In-Lamb & Empty Ewe Lamb Sale Rule Recipients carrying pedigree embryos will be allowed to be sold at the in lamb female sales after fully registered sheep.
- 17. All sheep entered at In-Lamb Sales to be scanned at time of Inspection.
- 18. Substitutes allowance per vendor at any sale three Shearling Rams and two per other sections. NONE allowed on the day.

Substitutes must be notified to the Auction Mart no later than 12noon Wednesday 3<sup>th</sup> September Substituted animals must be marked with a red dot on the loin

Note Re Point 15: Council advise the following: tick the box on the entry forms and make sure given out at time of sale. The Vendor discusses fully with the Purchaser details of retained semen / embryos, specifically whether for own use or if intending to sell that this is agreed between Vendor and Purchaser preferably in writing and signed by both parties.

### Inspections

- 19. Tags which do not comply with UK legislation and Society requirements will result in the sheep being rejected at inspection. From 2008 all registered lambs must carry tags with the Society logo. Check that tags are correct at time of entry, so that replacement tags can be ordered before the sale.
- 20. All sheep forward must be back-stamped with the lot number, failure to do so will result in rejection.
- 21. Sheep which have failed inspection must be marked with a purple dot & removed immediately from the market premises. Vendors are advised to check their animals thoroughly prior to departure from home.
- 22. Any animal put out for testicle abnormality or incorrect mouth is not allowed to be entered or substituted at following Society sales.
- 23. Inspection will include the following points: Tags, Teeth, Testicles, Udder, Muscularity and any other points deemed necessary by Council as they see fit.

### 27. Inspection Standards

- a. Teeth to be inspected and assessed at the discretion of the inspector / veterinary officer. No tampering is allowed.
- b. Sheep should be mobile and rams capable of natural service.
- c. Testicles should be of even size, move freely and be free of abnormalities.
  - Minimum Testicle Size: Ram Lambs 27cms, Shearling Rams & Aged Rams 30cms
- d. Double Muscling, the animal should display double-muscled gigots.
- e. Udder should be correct and free of abnormalities.
- f. Fleece should be tight. A medium fleece may be acceptable.

The Vets decision will be final at each sale.

#### 28. Shows at Sales

- a. Each vendor is allowed two entries in each pre-sale show class, except at the Carlisle Premier Sale where there is only one entry per class.
- b. All exhibitors should always be dressed in a white coat in the show rings.
- c. Exhibitors are permitted to prepare their sheep to the best of their ability.
- d. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that each exhibit is available for judging at the correct time.
- e. All prize winners must be offered for sale at auction by the exhibitor at the sale following the show. Awards may be withheld and prize monies will be forfeited unless prize winners are sold by auction.

The decision of the judge is final.

38 Female sheep not described as In Lamb

### 38.1 Vendor's warranty

The Vendor warrants that a female sheep not described in any catalogue for sale or at the time of sale as In Lamb is not In Lamb at the time of sale. This warranty is a 14 Week + 5 Day Warranty.

### 38.2 Purchaser's rights

If the *Purchaser* proves a breach of warranty then, at the Purchaser's option, either the *Purchaser* may exercise his rights under Schedule 6, or the Vendor shall pay to the *Purchaser as Liquidated Damages* a sum equal to the amount in paragraph (i) of the Appendix. Notice of a claim must be supported by a *Veterinary Surgeon's Certificate* or a slaughterhouse manager's or other competent person's certificate confirming that the sheep was In Lamb

39 Female sheep described as correct

### 39.1 *Vendor's warranty*

The *Vendor* warrants that all female sheep described in the catalogue or at the time of sale as correct are sound in mouth and udder, that is they are not lacking any of the 8 broad teeth and do not have any damaged or worn teeth or a defective udder. This warranty is a *5 Day Warranty*.

### 39.2 Purchaser's rights

If the *Purchaser* proves a breach of warranty then, at the Purchaser's option, either the *Purchaser* may exercise his rights under Schedule 6, or the *Vendor* shall pay to the Purchaser as *Liquidated Damages* a sum equal to the amount in paragraph (i) of the Appendix. Notice of a claim must be supported by *Veterinary Surgeon's Certificate*.

40 Female sheep proving barren

### 40.1 Vendor's warranty

The Vendor warrants that any female sheep sold as being In Lamb is In Lamb at the time of sale. This warranty is a 21 Day Warranty.

### 40.2 Purchaser's rights

If the *Purchaser* proves a breach of warranty he may exercise his rights under Schedule. Notice of a claim must be supported by a *Veterinary Surgeon's Certificate*.

43 Stock rams

#### 43.1 Vendor's warranty

The *Vendor* warrants that any ram sold as a stock ram for the amount in paragraph (j) of appendix or more is capable of natural service. This warranty lasts from the day of sale to the *15th December* in the year of the sale.

### 43.2 Purchaser's rights

If the *Purchaser* proves a breach of warranty the *Purchaser* may return the ram to the *Vendor* who shall, at the Purchaser's option, either replace the ram with another ram of equal value which is capable of natural service, or refund the purchase price together with such other costs and

charges as the *Purchaser* may be entitled to under these Conditions.

For the avoidance of any doubt if the Purchaser is able to obtain viable semen from the ram for use by artificial insemination he shall not be entitled to any claim against the *Vendor for breach of warranty*.
